BREEDER, TITLE-HOLDER & AFFILIATE MEMBERS:

CIOPORA contributions by breeder, title-holder and affiliate members consist of a basic fee and a turnover-related fee. The turnover-related fee* is calculated on the basis of the company's annual income from breeding and/or royalties as well as from any other activity related to asexually reproduced horticultural varieties.
