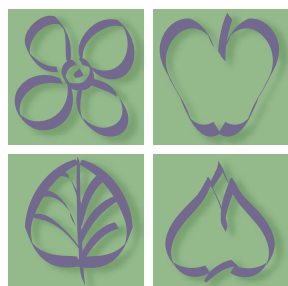

The Castle of the Counts and the Surroundings

TUESDAY, APRIL 24

Start: 10 am at the Marriott Ghent. Duration: 2 h

Group rate: EUR 80.00 + Museum Fee EUR 10.00/p. p.

Visit a medieval stronghold built by a crusader count of Flanders in XII century. Situated today in the very heart of Ghent, the building served as a seat of the Supreme Law Court from the XIVth to the XVIIIth. Now a museum, it showcases a collection of medieval arms and torture instruments.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 25

Start: 9 am at the Marriott Ghent. Duration: 3 h

Group rate: EUR 110.00 + EUR 4.00/p.p. Altar Piece entrance fee and EUR 5,00 for food & beverages

Walk the streets of Ghent's medieval Old Town and admire its architectural diversity, beautiful alleys, squares, and buildings. Visit St. Bavo's Cathedral and wonder at its art collection, including the world-famous altarpiece The Adoration of the Mystic Lamb by the Van Eyck brothers.

Start: 2 pm at the Marriott Ghent. Duration: 2 h

Group rate: EUR 80.00 excluding entrance fees

The entire floor of the recently renovated STAM Museum is covered with an aerial map of the city, causing enthusiastic Gentenaars and travelers to drop down and seek out their homes, hotels or landmarks. STAM focuses on the city's historical development from a medieval merchant hub to a modern cultural center. The museum building combines unique features of XIV, XVII and XXIst centuries' architecture - an ideal combination to reflect the long history of Ghent.
